Dear Editor,

Well done on successfully completing your course in Journalism! You have one final challenge to complete before we put you in charge of your own English newspaper. We need to make sure that you have the skills to work under pressure and to a tight deadline.

It is often the case that important events happen just before the newspaper is about to go to print, so it's vital that you are able to work well in a team, manage your time effectively and listen carefully to instructions.

On the day of your assessment you will be working with a top team of reporters. As the editor you will need to decide before the day which members of your team are best suited to the following roles:

- Photographer
- Researcher
- 1 or 2 Reporters

You will be in charge of organising the team and making decisions. Your photographer will take photos, your researcher will write down the answers to the challenges and your reporters will be on hand to do anything else that needs to be done, such as interviewing a tourist! Although you have separate jobs it is important that you all stay together and communicate well.

To save time on the day, you will need to complete your press pass beforehand. Using the template provided by your teacher, you need to add your newspaper title, your name, your role and a logo. You need to make sure that each of your team members does one too!

There will be seven assignments to complete, as well as two bonus challenges for extra points. You will be given instructions on the day, so you will need to listen carefully.

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You must try to complete as many assignments as you can to win the most amount of points and get your newspaper to print before the other groups!

There are only four rules:

- Communicate only in English
- Work together and finish together
- Always be polite - to each other, to your teachers and to the local people
- Arrive back at the meeting point on time, even if you haven't finished

If you don't follow the rules, you may be disqualified!
