For this Scavenger Hunt your students will be “The ultimate Alchemist”.

Collecting information from the environment and using their knowledge about alchemy (included in this guide), learning from their experiences, try to find and discover in their souls the true power within. The source of knowledge and wisdom, for eternal health.

Working in groups of four or six they will carefully read instructions, answer questions, and complete the challenges or “assignments”. The introduction will take place at the meeting point, where your students will be told everything about the activity. After the introduction they will be given their “clipboard packs” which will contain everything they need. There will be six assignments.

There will be a max of 6 teams, made of 4-6 students, they will need to choose a name and a team leader, who will be responsible for making sure everyone in their team takes part and that everyone finishes on time.
